

Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM) regulation

The Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM) regulation introduces a tariff on carbon intensive products, such as steel, cement, and some electricity imported to the European Union.

After a thorough review, we have determined that the CBAM regulation does not apply to most of our products, as it only applies to goods we sell with the following tariff codes:

- 7318: Screws, bolts, nuts, coach screws, screw hooks, rivets, cotters, cotter pins, washers (including spring washers) and similar articles, of iron or steel.
- 7607: Aluminum foil (whether or not printed or backed with paper, paperboard, plastics or similar backing materials) of a thickness (excluding any backing) not exceeding 0.2mm.
- 7616: Other articles of aluminum.

These are the only products potentially impacted: as specified in Annex I and Annex II of the CBAM regulation, if the value of these goods does not exceed EUR 150 per consignment, the CBAM regulation does not apply.
